## **Correct School uniform**

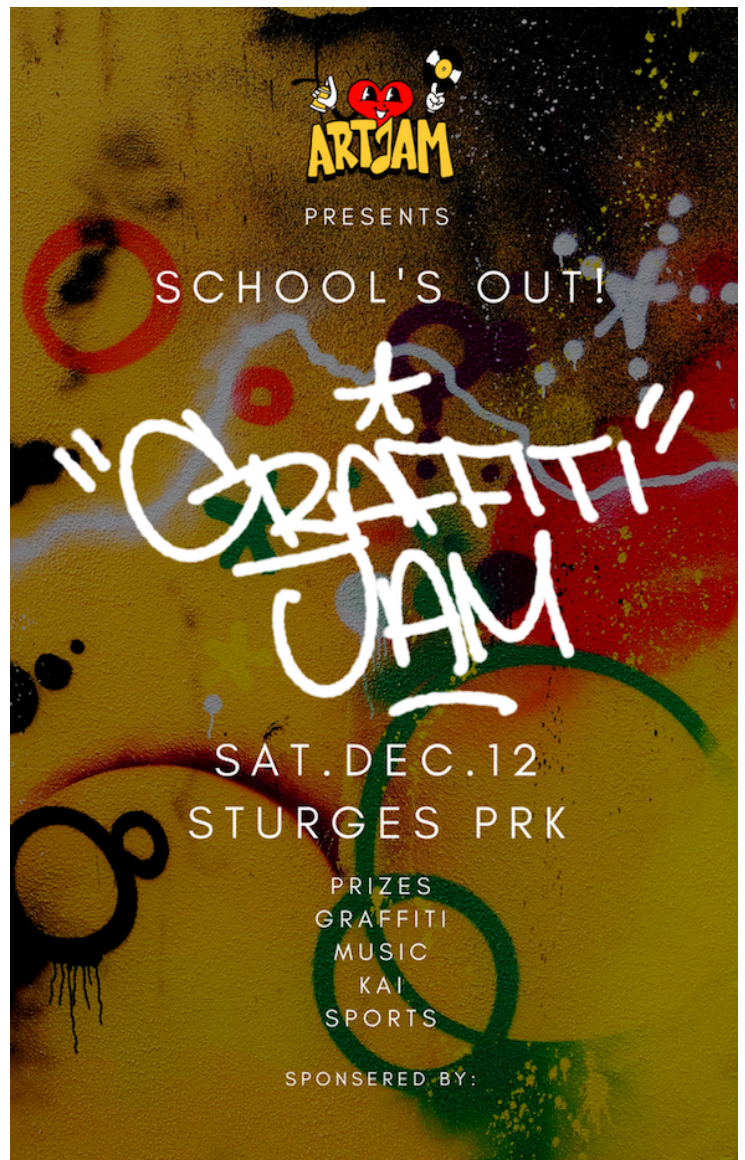
