Level 3 Lockdown

- On-line learning provisions for students at home.
- Sutton Park School opens only for staff and students. All outside visits will be by appointment.
- Students will be learning in bubbles.
- There will be contact tracing protocols when visiting the school.
- The school gates will be locked from 9:00am until after school.
