Level 3 Lockdown

Students who cannot be supervised at home are at school. Stay home and avoid mixing with people from other areas. Do have a Covid19 test if you have flu-like symptoms and wait for the test results before you go out. Children's learning will be either on-line or using the Learning Packs provided.

Level 2 Lockdown

In case we go down to Level 2, this means the school is open to all students except for those who are unwell. We have protocols and resources in place so that our students are safe. The school is open only to students and staff. The school gates are locked at 8:00am until after school.

On-Line Learning

We aim to make on-line learning part of the learning for our students especially from Years 5-8. Teachers will inform students of the lessons that are on-line so that they can be ready. Please make space for students at home for these lessons. You are most welcome to be in the vicinity when these lessons are on, so that you have some understanding of what is being learnt in case you can help.

Learning at Home

Please use this opportunity to teach your child some things that ONLY you can. There are many aspects of being Maori, Tongan, Fijian, Niuean, Rarotongan, Vietnamese, Samoan, Indian, Asian, Palagi that we cannot teach at school. Some aspects that are special and unique to WHO our students are can only be delivered at home. Do make the best of the opportunity now provided by the lockdown.

- Sutton Park School opens only for staff and students. All outside visits will be by appointment.
- Students will be learning in bubbles.
- There will be contact tracing protocols when visiting the school.
- The school gates will be locked from 9:00am until after school.

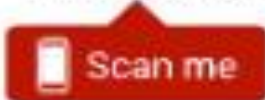


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
