1. Airport Park and Ride, Verisimmo Drive, Mangere

Open every day 8.30am - 4pm

You do not need to book an appointment to attend the drive-through vaccination site.

We encourage everyone 12 years and over to come for your vaccination together. We can vaccinate 4 people per car in the drive-through. If you would prefer to book a specific time to be vaccinated at one of our other sites, go to bookmyvaccine.nz or call and use the essential worker code BHTGZO9711 when prompted or call the Vaccination Helpline, 0800 28 29 26 and someone will help you find a location and time that suits you.
