Vaccination

i. Students twelve years and over are to be fully vaccinated to be at school. Students turning twelve during the year are to get their first vaccination prior to turning twelve, and three weeks later get their second vaccination. The school maintains a register of students twelve and over of their vaccination status.

ii. The Board of Trustees encourages all parents to vaccinate their children as protection against Omicron. There will be vaccination drives at the school and the community will be advised in advance. These dates will be made known once they are confirmed.

The Board reserves the right to mandate this for all students at Sutton Park and may do so, if needed to maintain the children's safety at school.
