# World Drowning Prevention Day (25 July)

World Drowning Prevention Day is a time to honour the lives lost to drowning and to raise awareness of the magnitude and preventability of drowning worldwide.

# Floating saves lives

Drowning is one of the leading causes of accidental death in Aotearoa, but it doesn't have to be. This year, we continue to focus on the lifesaving *Float first* technique.

If you find yourself in trouble in the water:

- Float first
- Breathe normally
- Signal for help
- Survive by swimming or floating

Practise these techniques – in a safe and controlled environment – so you know what to do. How you react in those first two minutes will make all the difference.
